“Time for the sleepyheads to wake up!” That was a common refrain throughout Sister Theodula’s life – in her role as a nun, as the first female professor in a Catholic seminary, and as an author. She fought against the Nazi regime in Germany, against apartheid in South Africa and against the dated sexual morals of the Catholic Church. A brave and strong woman, in the eyes of Florian Neuhann, her 29-year-old great-nephew. But what was it that made her become a nun? As someone who had little time for the Church, he put this question to her again and again as they travelled together across South Africa. Her responses led them not only to the sites where she had carried out her work, but also to a deep engagement across the generations with the themes of life and death, God and faith, resistance and politics, men and sex.

Florian Neuhann (b. 1980) studied politics, communications and European law at the universities of Munich and Bologna. He is a graduate of the *German School of Journalism* in Munich. He has worked as a reporter and editor for the German broadcaster *ZDF* since 2006. He also writes for numerous daily newspapers and magazines.

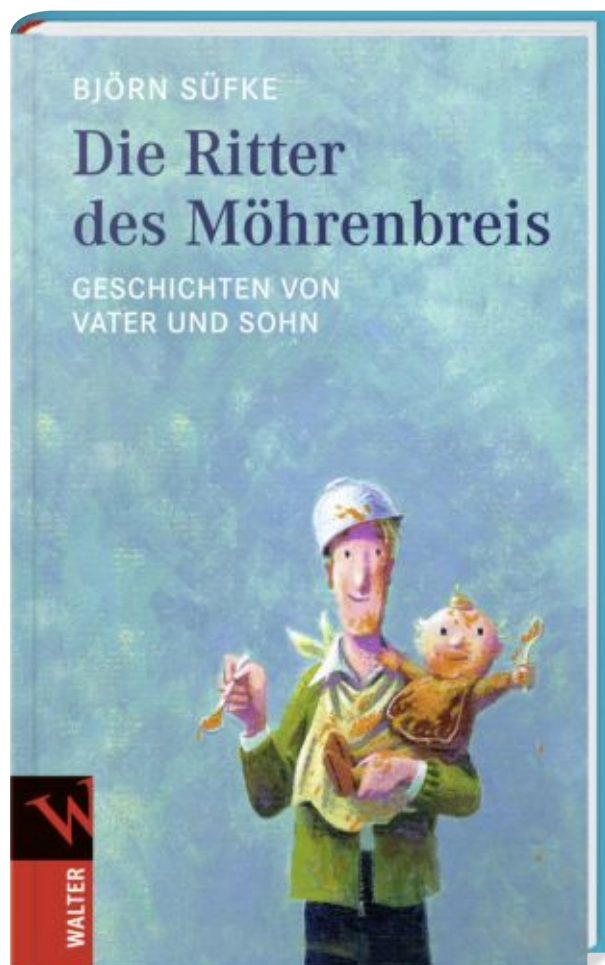
Cuddles, coaching or tough love?

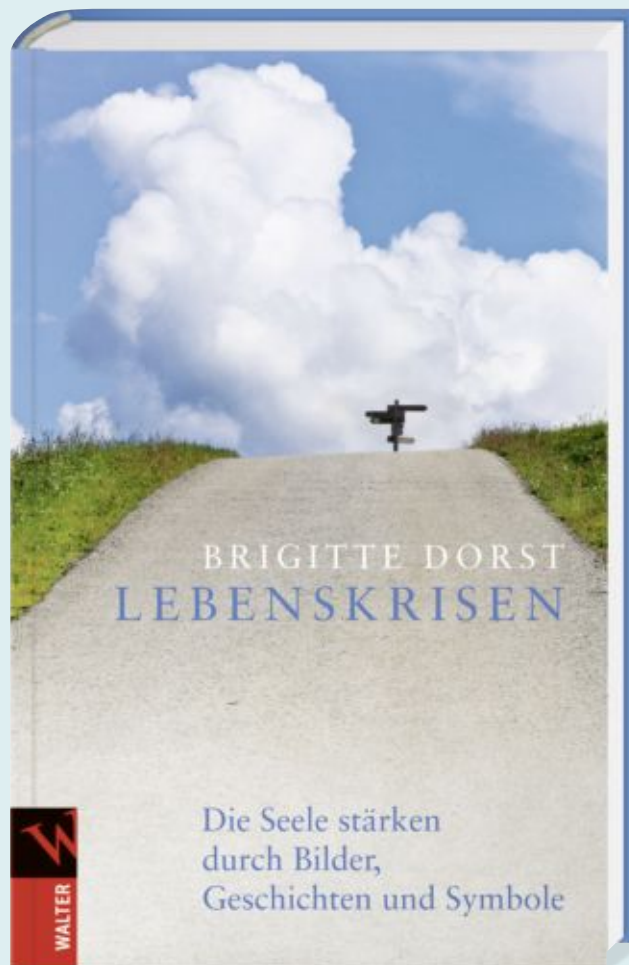

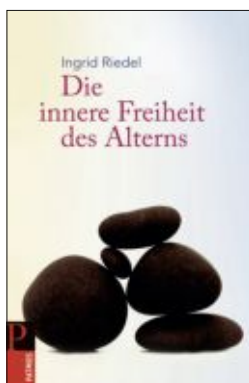
